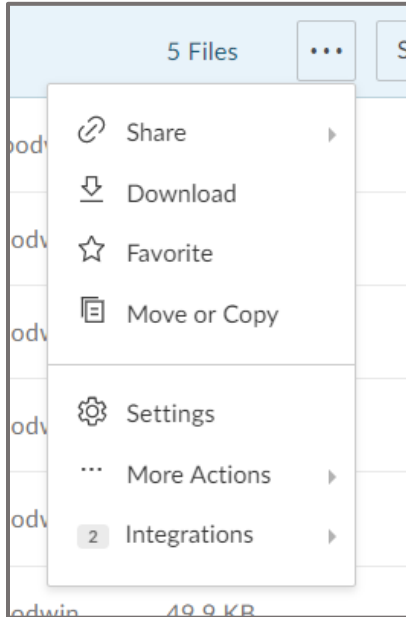


Embedding an Uploading Folder from Box into Moodle:

This would be for students to upload files directly to a folder in Box from Moodle. Any files uploaded to this folder would NOT appear in Moodle, just the folder in Box.

- Go to Box and navigate to the folder you would like students to be able to upload to and you want to embed into Moodle.
- Click on the three dots to get more options



- Select *More Actions* from the menu.
- Select *Upload Embed Widget*.
- Set up the title of the folder and any instructions for the uploaders,
- If you would like the uploaders to add descriptions and/or require email addresses from the uploaders (so you know who uploaded which file), select the boxes in front of those options.
 - If you would like to see a preview, click preview.

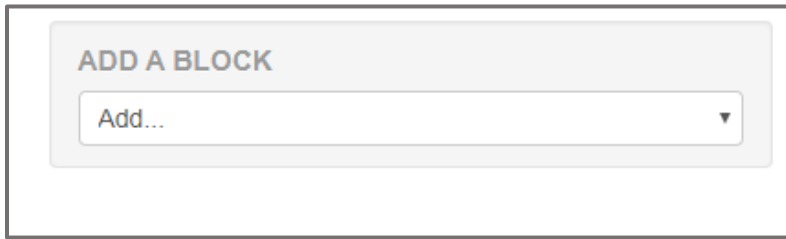

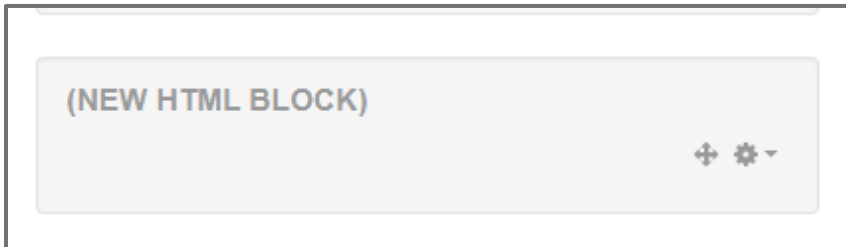
Deactivate Preview

- Click *Copy* to copy the embed code.
- Go to Moodle and navigate to the course for which you want to embed the folder.
- Turn on editing.

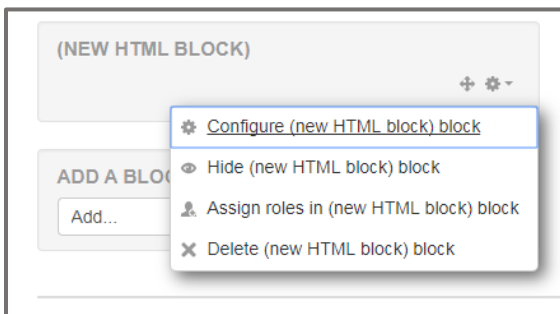
- Find the Block that is called Add Block. (Depending on the themes, this block is in different locations.)



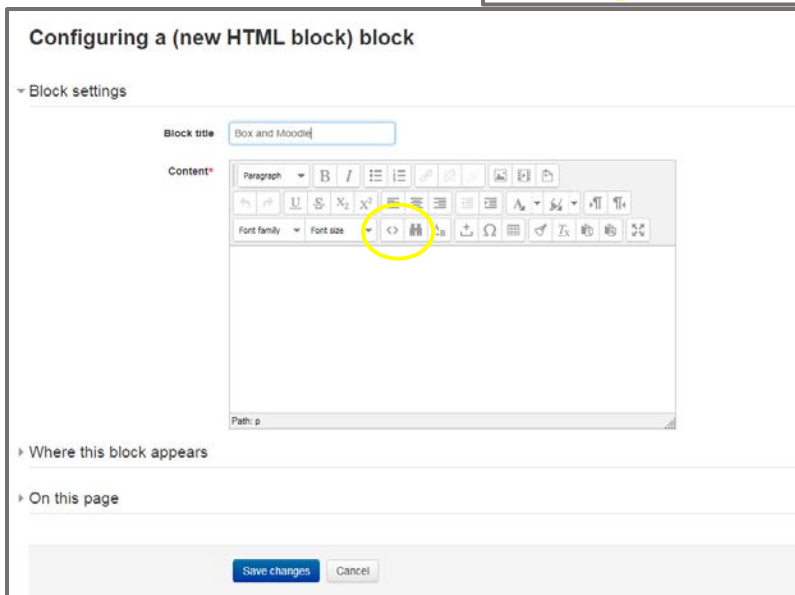
- Select HTML from the list of options.
- Scroll to the new HTML Block. (Again, depending on the theme, this block will be in different locations.)



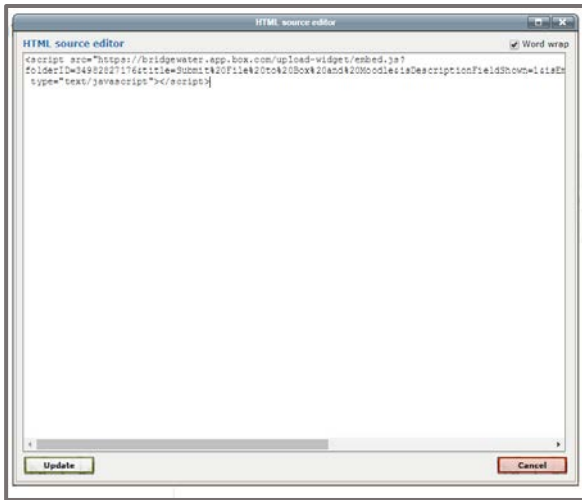
- Click on the settings icon and select Configure (new HTML block) block.



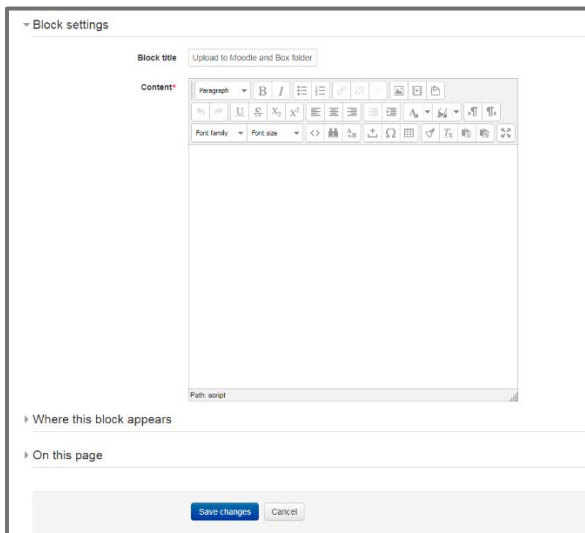
- Add the Block name.
- Click on the HTML code icon.



- Paste the embed code from the folder in Box and click update.



- Your Box folder may appear. (Mine did not but it worked anyway.)
- Click Save.



- You will see your Box upload folder embedded into your Moodle course.
